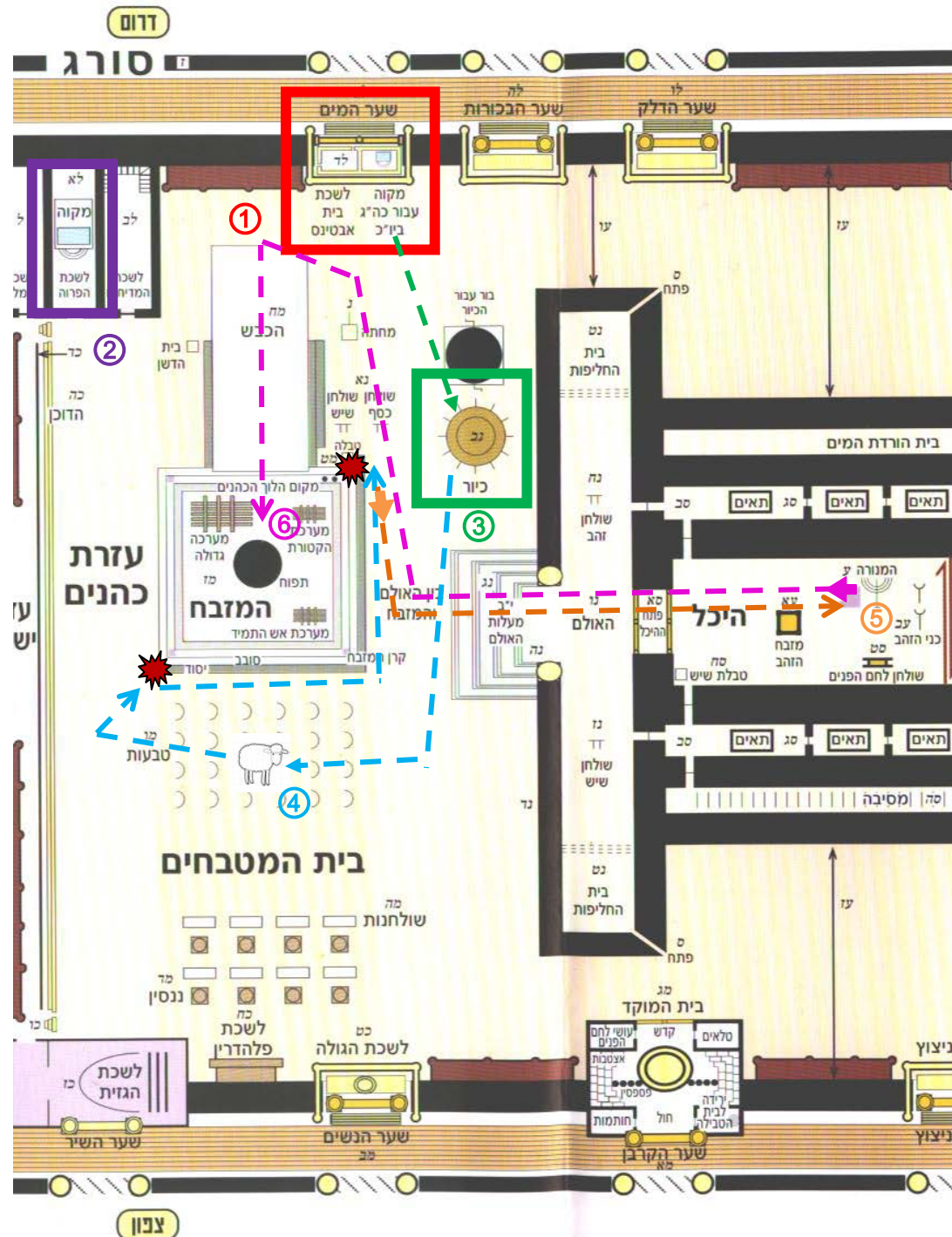


Yoma – Perek 3:3-4



① Mishna 3: On Yom Kippur morning after spending the night in the **Lishkas Beis Avtinas** the Kohen Gadol would immerse in a mikveh next door in the **Sha'ar HaMayim**. Technically this was not considered within the Kodesh/Azarah itself, because it was located on top of the wall. This was the only one out of the five Yom Kippur tevilos where this was true.

② Mishna 3: The other four tevilos would all take place in the mikveh of the **Beis HaParvah**, a room completely within the walls surrounding the Kodesh area.

③ Mishna 4: After removing his linen clothes, immersing in mikveh ① and then changing into Bigdei Zahav with gold thread, he would wash his hands and feet using the **Kiyor**.

④ Then he would go to the area north of the Altar and make the initial cut to slaughter the Tamid lamb (or goat), receive the blood in a bowl, and sprinkle it on the northeast and southwest corners of the Mizbeach.

⑤ After sprinkling he enters the Heichal to prepare the neiros of the Menorah and offer the daily Ketores (incense).

⑥ Finally he exited the Heichal, retrieved the dissected Tamid pieces from the Kevesh/ramp, and went up to offer the head, limbs, chavitin and wine nesachim on top of the Mizbeach.
